- Airship 2.0 alpha milestone completed in May
 - End to end demonstration of provisioning workflow
- June Virtual PTG meeting update
 - Higher participation than usually seen in person
 - Included updates on secrets, deployment configurations, and AirshipUI
 - Good cross-team collaboration with StarlingX, Ironic, and Edge Working Group
 - Future opportunities for alignment with StarlingX
- Airship now has a formal Vulnerability Management Process
 - Inspired by OpenStack's process
- Adoption of GitHub Issues
 - Facilitates collaboration across projects

- Airship is entering second cycle of governance
 - \circ TC elections this month, WC elections in July

- We published two stable releases end of last week 1.11.1 and 1.10.5
 - \circ these releases include security fixes for <u>CVE-2020-2023</u> and <u>CVE-2020-2026</u>.
- Kata 2.0 release uses the rust agent as default and makes the switch to ttrpc from grpc as the communication protocol.
 - o <u>2.0.0-alpha1</u>

- Confirmed as a full project at the June BoD!!!
- The latest stable release is 3.0 from Jan 2020.
- 4.0 release cycle
 - We are pushing to MS-3 toward a July 2020 release.
 - Larger work items during this cycle:
 - Upversions to OpenStack Ussuri and kernel 4.18.
 - StarlingX platform upgrade support
 - FPGA support enhancements
 - Certificate Management support with cert-manager
 - Kata Containers support

Community Updates

- User adoption is growing but hard to measure
- Are you using StarlingX? Please take the <u>user survey</u> and provide anonymous feedback to the community.



- Laying groundwork for Zuul v4 and v5
 - a. Zuul v5 will be more scalable and reliable
 - b. All components can scale out; no single point of failure
 - c. Zuul v4 is the transition period. Upgrade from v4 to v5 should be seamless
 - d. Upgrading from v3 to v4 requires some changes for operators
 - i. Make sure you have an SQL database
 - ii. Make sure all components can connect to ZooKeeper using TLS
 - e. Last v3 release has already been made (3.19.0) First v4 release expected soon
- New serial pipeline manager for continuous deployment
- Improved support for managing release jobs in-tree
- Better support for streaming log output for Kubernetes jobs
- GCE Nodepool driver
- Gitlab Zuul driver progressing



Project Introduction

A community, created by and for cloud operators, testing open source code in production, publishing complete, reproducible stacks for existing & emerging workloads, to advance open source infrastructure.

Project Updates

- Moved to GitLab to be more accessible to the operator community
- Open Cloud monitoring requirements discussions ongoing in GitLab board
- Mass Open Cloud and New England Research Cloud (NERC) Architecture's actively being defined
- Red Hat's Operate First Initiative, introduced at the Red Had Summit, has joined the community.
- Project Caerus proposed to address distributed compute and distributed storage



- Tools: Zoom, Meetpad, IRC, Etherpad, PTGbot




PTG Participation by Day*
